

## **ICF Deutschland Enjoys Success at their twelfth Coachingtag**

For the twelfth time, the German of the International Coach Federation (ICF) organised the trade and public congress known as „Coachingtag“. Over 200 coaches and interested visitor from companies accepted the invitation to München and experienced 2 packed days under the banner „Agile Leadership in a Digital World“. As an international organisation, die ICF naturally saw to it that at least one session every hour was held in English so that international speakers were also heard.

On Friday the participants were treated to presentations and discussions on topics such as „Coaching at Silicon Valley“ from Jean-Francois Cousin, President ICF global, „No Story. No Glory.“ from Markus Gull, an internationally sought after Keynote-Speaker with Hollywood-experience und expert for storytelling; and "Positive Leadership with PERMA LEAD©" from Dr. Markus Ebner, researcher at the university of Wien und Klagenfurt.

Both the local and international visitors alike were entranced by Dr. Birgit Feldhusen, academic director at the Department of Business and Management Science at the Donau-University in Krems with her talk „I, We, It – Who’s Leading?“, Jonathan Passmore, prizewinning Coach and Professor at Henley Business School UK, with his English speech „Masters of Coaching – the role of reflection“ and Edith Coron with „Coaching and AI“.

Additionally several HR-Experts from Siemens, Adidas, IBM and VW were invited as speaker to present their companies’ coaching concepts.

On Saturday the BarCamp awaited visitors – an innovative Campus format, in which the coaches and trainers hold workshops or live demonstrations on different topics in 45minute sessions.

The highlight of the two days was the gala presentation of the 2<sup>nd</sup> German Prism Award on Friday evening.

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
